Group Emission Reduction Update

REPORTING ON SCOPE 1, 2 AND 3 EMISSIONS

In line with the reporting obligations linked to Accor's 2021 Sustainability-linked Bond, Accor provides periodic reporting on progress towards the defined KPIs. This reporting compliments reporting on scope 1 and 2 emissions detailed in the 2021 Universal Registered Document, published on March 30th, 2022. Accor's current reporting process includes a consolidation of global purchasing data used for the calculation of Scope 3 emissions. This data was however not available at the time of the Universal Registered Document publication. Subsequently Accor issues this complimentary summary of emissions and progress tracking against the Group target trajectory. The scope of reporting is consistent with the Accor Sustainability-linked bond framework published November 2021.


Accor's global hotels operations were significantly impacted in 2020 by the global COVID19 pandemic. Accor experienced a significant return of business during 2021 following the relaxation of health-related restrictions. This change of business activity is reflected as an increase in emissions between 2020 and 2021. As business activity returns to 2019 levels, further emission increases are anticipated in 2022. Accor is focused on providing hotels with the tools and capabilities to reduce emissions. The benefits of these capabilities will progressively reduce emission over the coming years and enable the Group to achieve the published KPIs and targets.

KPI # 1 - Scope 1 & 2 Emissions Reduction

Accor scope 1 and 2 emissions during 2021 are below the 2025 and 2030 emission reduction trajectory.






KPI # 2 - Scope 3 Emissions Reduction
